



MCBC 6th Business Excellence Awards 2010 AWARD NOMINATION GUIDELINES

Industry Excellence in Science & Technology

The MCBC 6th Business Excellence Awards 2010 are designed to recognize achievements and contributions of successful businesses in Malaysia. The awards will be presented at an awards dinner gala on November 10, 2010. Winners will receive an award trophy and must agree to be featured in MCBC's magazine, "The Bridge".

The Award for Industry Excellence in Science & Technology will be given to a company/institution that has introduced or developed systems/processes to improve the quality of life, enhance manufacturing processes, and/or made an advanced or innovative breakthrough.

Criteria

The criteria for this category are as follows:

- ✚ The introduction or development of a new scientific application, method or technology
- ✚ A commitment to excellence as well as ongoing research and development
- ✚ Contribution to social well-being/corporate responsibility
- ✚ Committed to enriching lives through scientific advancement
- ✚ Contributing to Malaysia's overall development

Nomination package requirements

Your nomination package should include the following:

- ✚ Completed questionnaire
- ✚ Application fee
- ✚ Current company literature or brochures
- ✚ Photos, videos, or other graphic items in print and soft copy (e.g. JPG or TIF format)
- ✚ Soft copy of the company's logo in EPS format with fonts outlined for use in PowerPoint presentations, banner, and publications
- ✚ Anecdotal evidence/examples of business excellence during the past two years of operation

Award Rules

Nominations are open to members of the Malaysia Canada Business Council and/or any successful Canadian/Malaysian companies/institutions.

The nominations will be judged by an independent selection committee established by the MCBC. The committee will be endorsed by the MCBC Board of Governors and will comprise the President of the MCBC, the BEA Chairman, a senior representative from the Canadian High Commission, the MCBC Executive Director, MCBC members-at-large, and high profile Malaysian industry players.

The selection committee reserves the right to not present an award in any of the advertised categories. The decisions of the selection committee will be final and no appeals will be considered.
